

Treatment Plant/Distribution System Technician

The Norwood Water Commission is currently accepting applications for the position of Treatment Plant/Distribution System Technician. This is a full-time, entry level position assisting in the operation and maintenance of the surface water treatment plant and distribution system under the general direction of the Operator in Responsible Charge "ORC". Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, monitoring, maintaining & repairing plant equipment, maintaining & repairing water main lines, monitoring supply tanks, reading water meters and all other duties assigned by supervisor. Knowledge of small motors, pumps and valves is a plus. Applicant must be able to obtain a Class "D" water treatment certification and a class 1 distribution certification within first year of employment. Must be a High School graduate or equivalent and in possession of a valid Colorado driver's license. Experience with heavy equipment or utility construction is a plus. Must be able to lift 100 lbs. and able to work in adverse weather conditions for long periods of time. Applicant must be willing and able to work a schedule that includes on call hours, weekends and holidays. A pre-employment physical exam and drug screen may be required. Must provide a driving history from DMV.
